Logo Usage

Color



The Dorchester County logo is comprised of two colors: Pantone 349 and Pantone 7692. All marketing materials should be created with these colors when possible. If Pantone spot colors are not available, use the 4-color process alternative. For use on the web or other instances where traditional 4-color process or Pantone colors are not available, use the RGB / Hexadecimal builds listed below.

Grey scale



RGB: 0, 107, 53
CMYK: 90, 12, 95, 40
HEX: 006B35

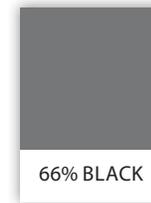
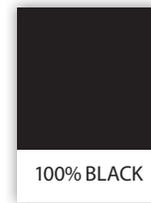


RGB: 0, 74, 124
CMYK: 100, 45, 0, 45

Black



When printing in grey scale, use 100% black to represent Pantone 349 and 66% black to represent Pantone 7692.



Reversed



When printing in black only, use 100% for all values.

In all black or one-color applications, reverse the logo out to white.

Logo Clearance



The Dorchester County logo should be kept clear from all other graphic elements within the standard height and width of the capital “D” in the logo as illustrated here.

Typeface



The typestyle for the Dorchester County logo is Uniform Medium.

CAUTION: The logo must never be redrawn, recreated, or imitated in any way. Always use an official version of the logo as there are many subtle nuances which make up the uniqueness of the logo.
