- **Continuances, Orders of Protection and/or Scheduling Orders**
 - 1) **Must be received by the Chief Administrative Judge no later than 14 Days prior to the scheduled Jury Term of Court.**
 - 2) **REQUESTS MADE AFTER THE 14 DAYS ARE HIGHLY DISFAVORED.**

- **The Chief Justice's Administrative Order provides that all Common Pleas cases in the State of South Carolina shall be disposed within 365 days from the date of the filing of the initial complaint.**
 - Options for cases older than 365 days
 - 1) Dismissal Under Rule 40
 - 2) Settlement
 - 3) Be prepared for trial.

Amended Scheduling Orders are highly disfavored.
